Dear Mr. Houser:

On November 12, 2008, members of the Boards of Supervisors of West Pikeland Township, East Nantmeal Township and West Vincent Township, sent you a letter concerning the above-mentioned project. As you may recall that letter was sent after a meeting attended by representatives of those three townships and representatives of the environmental and land preservation community including Green Valleys Association, the Charlestown Township Open Space Commission and French and Pickering Creeks Conservation Trust, and approximately 50 interest residents.

That letter requested that a meeting be set up as soon as possible with the appropriate representatives of Dominion Transmission to discuss these concerns and to hopefully begin a process which would ultimately result in the most appropriate route through northern Chester County.

In response to that letter, you called me to tell me that, at this time, Dominion believes that such a meeting would be premature. According to what you told me in our conversation, Dominion has placed the project on hold because of a number of issues including the recent fluctuation in natural gas prices, the lack of subscription for the pipeline's throughput, and ongoing discussions with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection concerning the disposal of the fluids which will be injected into production wells.

I have been in communication with representatives of the Townships and they agree that, based upon your representations, the meeting would be premature. However, the Townships want to promptly schedule a meeting once the status of the project changes. Towards that end, I request that you contact me promptly once the status of the project

changes so that I can coordinate such a meeting. If you are unable or unwilling to honor that request, please let me know immediately. I will otherwise assume that I will hear from you as soon as the status of the project changes.

Thank you for your anticipated cooperation. Please contact me at the above-listed physical and email addresses and telephone numbers if you have any questions or concerns.
